TITLE: AIRCRAFT PAINTER

Structural Repair Department

RESPONSIBILITIES: To work as a team member within the structural repair

department of Preferred Airparts. Emphasis is the refinishing of aircraft structural and mechanical

components.

REPORTS TO: AIRCRAFT MANITENANCE SUPERVISOR,

Structural Repair Department

DUTIES AND TASKS:

- To prepare, prime and/or paint sheetmetal skins and structural components fabricated by the Structures Department for the repair of aircraft undergoing repair, or operated by Priority Air Charter.
- To repair and repaint fiberglass aircraft components to an original airworthy condition for the repair of aircraft undergoing repair, or operated by Priority Air Charter.
- To perform 1 or 2 above for parts either on inventory or for sale by Preferred Airparts.
- To maintain the inventory of consumable items associated with the job of repair and refinishing or aircraft sheetmetal and fiberglass components. A list of the required items and their minimum/maximum quantities to be agreed by the employee and his/her supervisor.
- To maintain cleanliness and serviceability of the paint shop and the equipment. Any damage. Missing or worn equipment must be reported to his/her supervisor.
- Safety: Preform work assignments in a safe and efficient manner.
- Other duties and tasks as assigned by management.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum of 2 years' college education in vehicle refinishing.
- Minimum of 2 years in the job described.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE POSITION:

- Bending, Stooping, Standing, Twisting, repetitively throughout the shift.
- Able to lift 50 lbs.
- Ability to climb ladders and stairs as needed.
- Must be able to abide by all safety rules and regulations, Industry Standards best practices, and those established by the Company.
- Wear all required PPE.
