

JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN, STRUCTURAL
Structural Repair Department.

RESPONSIBILITIES: To work as a team member within the structural repair department of Preferred Airparts. Emphasis is the sheetmetal structural repair of aircraft airframes.

REPORTS TO: AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR, Structural Repair Department

DUTIES AND TASKS:

- Repair of the sheetmetal structure of DC-3's and other aircraft including fuselage, wings, stabilizers and control surfaces, as part of the whole aircraft repair process.
- Assisting repair of the mechanical components of Cessna Caravans and reinstallation/rigging/test during the whole aircraft repair process.
- Repair of aircraft structural components including wings, stabilizers, control surfaces etc for sale by Preferred Airparts.
- Repair of structural defects and/or modification of aircraft operated by Priority Air Charter.
- Perform scheduled Airframe & Powerplant inspections and subsequent defect rectification as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum of 2 years college education in aviation technology.
- FAA Certification Airframe and Powerplant license.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE POSITION:

- Bending, Stooping, Standing, Twisting, Climbing Stairs, repetitively throughout the shift.
- Able to lift 50 lbs.
- Ability to climb ladders
